The FBI's Challenge



The FBI IT Supplies and Support Services (FBI IT Triple S) GSA Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) is a comprehensive Information Technology (IT) vehicle serving the FBI and all Department of Justice (DOJ) agencies. This BPA allows the FBI and DOJ agencies to acquire any IT products and solutions available on GSA Schedules. In addition the FBI needed vendor-specific subject matter expertise to support FBI Network and Systems Engineering requirements along with the full engineering lifecycle support for a variety of vendor and OEM technologies. They also required:

- Controlled environments for engineering testing and demonstration
- Secure interconnectivity between FBINET, DNI-S network, SIPRNET, and Information Workspace
- Secure Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) communication capabilities

The Technica Solution

Technica assembled a team of product solutions providers comprised of multiple large and small businesses with combined capabilities to support the broad spectrum of FBI IT Triple S requirements. The Technica Team provides:
